



ON THE MOVE

Pirate Ship Instructions



You Will Need...

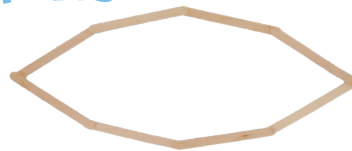
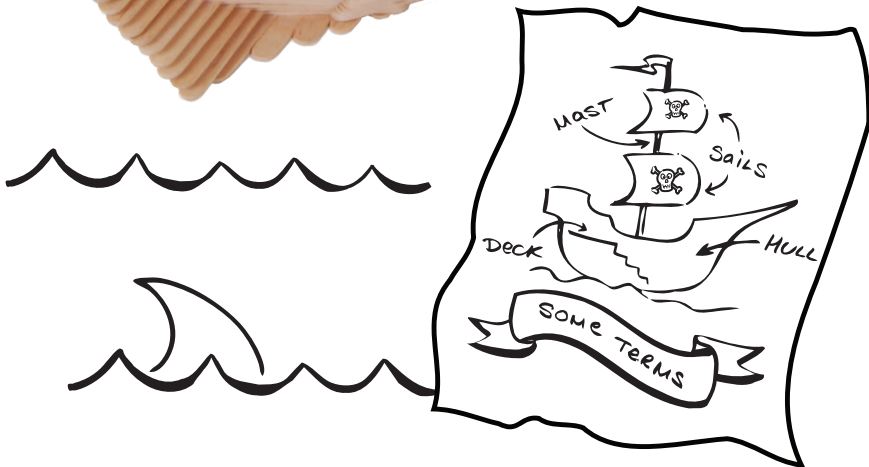
Craft Sticks

Glue

You Will Also Need...

Micador Scissors

Paper



OVERLAPPING
CRAFT STICKS

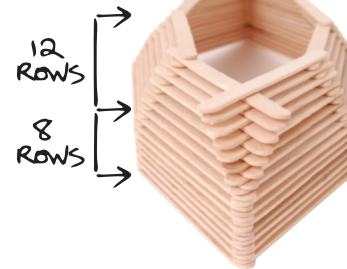
Step 1: Arrange 8 craft sticks to create the ship's hull (body). Every second craft stick will sit on top. Glue where the sticks come in contact.



Step 4: Slide 5 craft sticks between the two sides of the hull to create the deck. Slide another craft stick directly underneath. Ensure the edges line up.



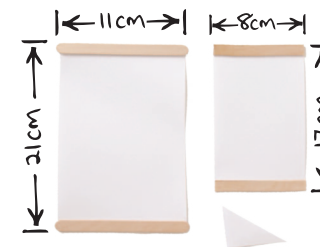
Step 7: Secure the mast in place by sliding and gluing a craft stick in front of it. Glue another 3 sticks (cut to size) into every second row of the hull under the deck to create the steps.



Step 2: Glue the next 7 rows of craft sticks directly above the first row by repeating Step 1. From the 8th row, move the sticks closer towards the centre on every layer by a couple of millimetres. Build 12 rows this way.



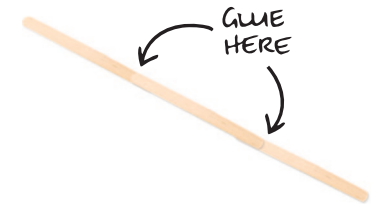
Step 5: Cut a craft stick in half and glue them in between the space created under the deck, roughly 1.5cm apart from each other. Leave roughly 0.5cm of the ends sticking out.



Step 8: Create the sails by cutting paper to size and gluing the edges to a couple of craft sticks. For the flag, simply cut out a triangle.



Step 3: Glue craft sticks diagonally across the gap to create the base of the ship. Once the glue has dried, turn the hull over.



Step 6: Glue 3 craft sticks together at the ends to create the mast. Insert and glue the mast vertically into the 1.5cm gap (Step 5).



Step 9: Glue the sails to the mast. Allow the sails to billow outwards. Glue the flag at the top of the mast. **TIP:** Use pegs to work out the positioning of the sails before gluing them on.
