Popsicle Stick Spider Web

Materials:

- White Yarn
- Elmers Glue
- Glitter
- Plastic Spider
 - O Not necessary, but you can add one if you like!

Instructions:

- 1. Glue three popsicle sticks together to make a star-like shape.
 - a. You can use Elmer's glue or hot glue. Hot glue can eliminate wait time for the glue to dry.
- 2. Cut a piece of yarn about 2-3 feet.
- 3. Tie the piece of yarn around the center of the popsicle sticks and tie a knot.
- 4. Wrap the yarn around each spoke of the web form.
 - a. You can get a better effect if you wrap over the top of each stick rather than underneath.
- 5. Keep working your way around, making sure to space the yarn a little apart.
- 6. When you fill the sticks, tie a knot and cut off any excess yarn.
- 7. You can tie long strings on the ends to hang.
- 8. Add a spider!

Halloween Mini Pinata

Materials:

- Toilet Paper Tube
- Googly Eyes
- White Streamer
- Tape
- Construction Paper
- String
- Small Toys and/or Candy

Instructions:

- 1. Apply a strip of tape to the edge of the toilet paper tube and use it to secure a piece of streamer in place.
- 2. Take the small toys and/or candy and put it inside the toilet paper tube.
 - a. Make sure not to pack it too tightly or else they will get stuck when you pull the string.
- 3. Cover the other end of the toilet paper tube just like before, but include a small tag before securing it.
 - a. This is where your kids can pull the string to release the prizes!
- 4. Wrap a white streamer around the tube until it is completely covered. Secure it with tape. Put googly eyes on the side to make a little mummy or ghost.


Bat Corner Bookmark

Materials:

- Black Origami Paper
 - Can use post-it note or construction paper, as long as the paper is a perfect square
- Black Paper
- Googly eyes
 - o Can use eye stickers as well
- White paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- Pencil

Instructions:

- 1. Fold the origami paper diagonally on both sides.
- 2. Fold into a triangle.
 - a. Make sure the colored side is on the outside.
- 3. Hold the top of the triangle and fold it towards the bottom of the triangle.
 - a. Make sure to crease well.
- 4. Take the left corner and fold it towards the bottom center of your triangle.
- 5. Do the same with the other corner.
 - a. Crease well!
- 6. Unfold both ends.
- 7. Grab onto the left corner and fold it towards the top of the triangle. Crease.
- 8. Do the same with the other corner.
- 9. Tuck in the left flap into the pocket.
- 10. Repeat with the other.
- 11. Glue two googly eyes to the bookmark.
- 12. Cut two wings out of black construction paper.
- 13. Cut two fangs out with white paper. Glue both of these to your bookmark.

Glitter Glue Spiderweb

Materials:

- Black Construction Paper
- Bottle of Elmers Glue
- Glitter

Instructions:

- 1. Squeeze a horizontal line of glue across the center of your paper.
- 2. Squeeze a large X for the foundation of your spider web.
- 3. Squeeze in a large hexagon/circular shape near the edges of the paper.
 - a. Do a second smaller shape inside the first to create your spider web!
- 4. Use the glitter to cover your glue spider web while the glue is still wet.
 - a. We recommend you do this over a paper plate or paper so then you can use the extra glitter to put it on again.
- 5. Lift your paper and shake it gently to remove the excess glitter.
- 6. You can add a fake spider or a pom-pom to represent a spider!

3D Paper Pumpkin

Materials:

- Four thin strips of orange paper
- Glue Stick
- Green paper to cut out for leaf
- Black Paper to cut out for eyes and mouth

Instructions:

- 1. Take four thin strips of orange paper and glue them into a star shape.
- 2. Take the opposing side and glue them together by folding up at the top in a dome shape.
 - a. Do this for all of the pieces until they are all glued at the top.
- 3. Use the green piece of paper to cut out a leaf and glue it to the top of the pumpkin.
- 4. Take the black piece of paper to cut out two eyes and a mouth and glue those onto the front of the pumpkin.
