



The Geneva Park District is excited to announce the 11th annual Super Shuffle 5K Race will be held in-person on **February 7th**! The state of Illinois has moved into a new level of the mitigation plan, which allows us to offer this event in-person.

We will be implementing race waves of 50 people to limit congregation. The first wave of the 2021 Super Shuffle will kick off at 10AM! We have had to make some adjustments to the event in order to keep our runners and staff safe, and to be in compliance with the state's guidelines. Please read all of the information below:

Face Covering & Social Distancing Requirements

- Face coverings will be required at all times, including while lining up for the start of the race
 - The starter will inform racers when they can take off their face covering
- Face coverings are encouraged but not required during the race
- Face coverings should be put back on as quickly as possible once you cross the finish line
- Participants are required to social distance, at least 6 feet, from others as much as possible

Race Heats/Waves

In order to stay under our limit of gatherings of 50 people, we will start a wave of 50 runners every 15 minutes, beginning at 10AM. You will register for a particular wave time. All runners are chipped timed, so no matter when you start, your time will be accurate. We will not have access to any indoor facilities for this race, so please plan ahead and arrive close to your wave start time, or stay warm in your car until your wave start time.

Course

The Super Shuffle 5K course will be the same as in past years, starting on Viking Drive and ending on the park path near the softball fields. See course map attached. This event will run regardless of the weather conditions, so please plan ahead. We will be keeping one lane of Viking Drive open, as a one way lane, to allow participants to be able to arrive closer to their wave time, the other lane will be blocked off for runners. The open lane will be for race participants only! No through traffic will be allowed.

Registration/Package Pick-Up

You will have to register for a particular race wave. You must arrive on time to start the race at your designated time. As a result of us not having indoor facilities available, **we will not be able to process day of registration at the race.** We will keep registration open until 8:30pm Saturday, 2/6. **We strongly encourage you to pick up your race packet and bib before race day!** Directions on packet pick up will be emailed to race participants one week prior to the race. For those traveling farther, packet pick-up will be available on-site the morning of the race, but we strongly encourage packet pick-up ahead of race day.

*Anyone who picks up their packet at Packet Pick-up does NOT have to check-in prior to the start of the race.

Awards/After the Race

We will award medals and gift cards to Dick's Sporting Goods for the top male and female finisher in each of the typical age groups. Plaques and gift cards will be awarded to the overall male and female finishers. In order to be in compliance with the state's guidelines, **there will not be the typical after-party at SPRC this year.**

Participants are encouraged to leave the race site when finished. Results will be posted to the Park District website and the Race Roster website the Monday after the race. Top finishers will also be notified to pick-up their awards.

Parking

Parking will be available at the Geneva Middle School parking lots. Viking Drive will remain open as a one-way street for race traffic only during the event. See the attached parking map.

Race Hoodie Information

Early Registration (any racer registered on or before January 29): Race hoodies will be included with your packet pick-up.

Late Registration (any racer registered after January 29): Race hoodies will not be available on-site on the day of the race; immediately following the race a final shirt order will be placed. Upon arrival of the hoodies (about two weeks after the race) all participants will be notified. You will have 1 month to pick up your hoodies from SPRC.

Any racer that wishes to have their hoodie mailed to them can do so by paying a \$5.00 fee. That fee can be paid at SPRC during packet pick-up, or by calling 630-232-4501. ***IMPORTANT: Any hoodies that are not picked up racers by April 1, 2021 will be donated.***
