Welcome to Storybook Adventures Camp! We are so excited to spend the week celebrating our favorite fairy tales and stories. We will be doing themed crafts and games; like revving up our imaginations for a venture through the woods with Little Red Riding Hood, using Rapunzel's hair to capture villains, and finding that pesky pea that has been plaguing the princess. Please remember to send your child with a face mask. This year we are using a drop-off and pick-up line. When you arrive at 9am a staff will be out to greet you and your child. Upon pick-up, please have a piece of paper with your child's name in the car window, and have an ID ready. A staff will assist your child into the car. If they need help buckling, please pull forward before getting out of the car to assist them.

THINGS TO REMEMBER...

- Please **ALWAYS** have your ID ready when picking up your child! Only individuals with authorization from the parent/guardian can pick-up campers. Please remember to stay in your car. If your child needs assistance buckling up, please pull forward from the car line before getting out to help them!
- Please make sure your child brings a morning snack with them every day (it must be nut free!) along with a water bottle.
- To camp, your child should wear:
 - Sunscreen / Bug Spray
 - Gyms Shoes and Socks
 - Active Wear
 - Face Mask (to be worn when indoors)

If you wish to sign-up for more camps, registration must be in by **8pm the Wednesday prior to the session**, pending availability.

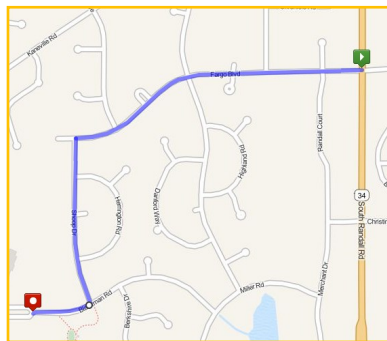
