NOTES FROM THE COORDINATOR

We have officially made it to Week 9 Adventure Camp Families!

How is the summer already over? We are so upset it is coming to an end and we don't want to say goodbye! We want to thank all of you for allowing us to get to know your children and spending the summer with them. We do have a few big changes for this week! For the last week we will be at Sunset Community Center instead of Harrison Street School. We will have an on-site water day on Monday. We will still be going to the pool on Tuesday. We will also be going to Wheeler Park on Wednesday and having our Virtual Field Trip on Thursday. Please make sure that you are dropping off and picking up from Sunset Community Center only. You may not drop off/pick up at any off site locations. If you are not able to drop your child off before we leave, they will not be able to come to camp that day. We ask that campers arrive at least 30 minutes before our departure times. For this week, we would appreciate it if everyone is dropped off by 10:30am on Tuesday and 8:30am on Wednesday.

Wheeler Park on Wednesday - Depart: 9:00am | Return: 1:45pm

Please make sure to send your child with a proper mask each day. Masks are not required while we are outdoors; however, they are required for any indoor activities. We do have extra masks, but they might be more comfortable in their own masks.

THINGS TO REMEMBER...

- Please <u>ALWAYS</u> have your ID ready when picking up your child!
 Only individuals with authorization from the parent/guardian can pick-up campers. Please remember to stay in your car, if your child needs assistance buckling up, please pull forward from the car line before getting out to help them!
- Please make sure your child brings a lunch, morning and afternoon snack with them every day (it must be nut free!), along with a reusable water bottle.
