THINGS TO REMEMBER...

- Please ALWAYS have your ID ready when picking up your child! Only individuals with authorization from the parent/guardian can pick-up campers. Please remember to stay in your car, if your child needs assistance buckling up, please pull forward from the car line before getting out to help them!
- Please make sure your child brings a reusable water bottle and a snack that does not need to be prepared (nut free!)
- Please have your child bring a proper mask. Masks are required for any indoor activities, but not required when outside. A proper face mask is one that aligns with CDC guidelines here: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/about-face-coverings.html>
- Participants must be potty trained to attend camp
- To camp, your child should wear: Leotard/athletic shorts, camp shirts, socks and gym shoes

Pick Up and Drop Off Procedures— Sunset Community Center

Drop Off: 8:45am-9:00am

- Parents/guardians will pull up to designated cones
- Campers will need to unbuckle themselves
- Staff will meet the camper at the vehicle, and open the door for them to exit
- Using a non-contact digital thermometer, all campers will have their temperature taken
- Any temperatures of 100.4 or more will not be permitted into camp
- After temperatures are taken, campers will use hand sanitizer prior to joining their group

Pick Up: 12:00pm-12:15pm

- Campers will be appropriately spaced during dismissal
- Parents and guardians are to remain in their vehicle
- Please have a piece of paper in your front window with your child's first and last name
- A staff member will check the parent/guardian ID
- When the child's name is called, they will proceed to staff that are at the designated cones
- Staff will open the door for the child to enter the car
- Staff not buckle children in the seat. If campers are unable to buckle themselves, then parent guardians will be asked to pull forward after their child is loaded into the car to secure their child
