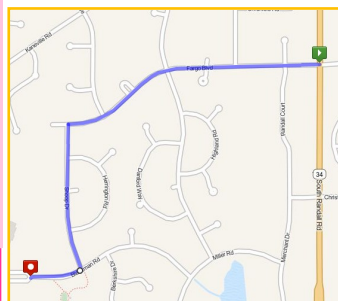

THINGS TO REMEMBER...
