GENERAL KIDS' ZONE REMINDERS

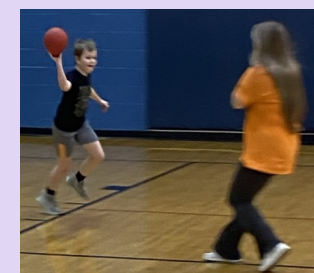
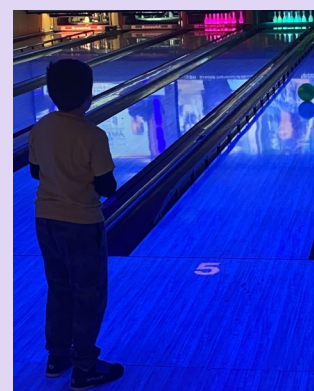
- We ask that you make sure the kids do NOT bring any toys from home. We don't want anything to go missing or break while at Kids' Zone.
