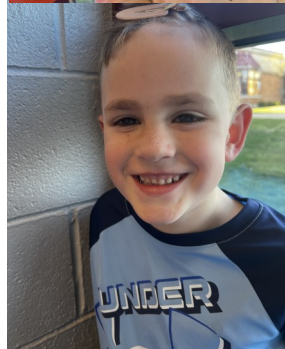
IMPORTANT DATES
