



Stuart Little Character Descriptions

Costumes are the responsibility of each cast member and must be approved by the Director by May 13.

| Character | Character Description | Costume Description |

| Narrator(s) | Tell the story of Stuart Little | |
| Stuart Little | A mouse | Needs base costume, bathrobe, toothbrush, blue jacket with patch pockets |
| Mr. Little | Stuart's Father | Base costume - male |
| Mrs. Little | Stuart's Mother | Base costume – female |
| George | Stuart's older Brother | Base costume - male |
| Neighbors | Live next to the Littles – gossip about their new small child | Base costume – male or female |
| Doctor | Doctor who examines Stuart when he arrives | Base costume – plus optional drs. jacket, medical gloves |
| Snowbell | The Little's cat | Base costume, white cat accessories such as ears, tail, optional cat nose and whisker makeup |
| Bureau Chief | Chief of the Bureau of Missing Persons - Talks on the phone to Mr. Little | Base costume, optional detective hat or police hat |
| Dog(s) | Chases Stuart around | Base costume and dog ears |
| Woman with Newspaper | Throws Stuart a newspaper and saves him from dog(s) | Base costume - female |
| Passengers | Passengers on the bus Stuart rides | Base costume – male or female |
| Bus Driver | Drives bus that Stuart rides | Base costume and bus driver hat |
| Dr. Carey | A dentist | Base costume – male, optional drs jacket and medical face mask, fake glasses, medical gloves |
| Leroy | A bully at the boat race | Base costume - male |
| Referee | Referee at the boat race | Base costume – optional referee shirt |
| Spectators | Spectators at the boat race | Base costume – male or female |
| Reporter | Reports the results of the boat race | Base costume |
| Margalo | An injured bird who lands on the Littles windowsill | Brown shirt and optional bird accessories such as wings, tail, beak |
| Zeke | A trashman | Base costume – work gloves |
| Hank | A trashman | Base costume – work gloves |
| Malty | Neighborhood cat who dislikes birds and mice | Base costume, cat accessories such as ears, tail, optional cat nose and whisker makeup |
| Babette | White neighborhood cat with a French accent who dislikes birds and mice | Base costume, white cat accessories such as ears, tail, optional cat nose and whisker makeup |
| Tige | Tiger-striped neighborhood cat who dislikes birds and mice | Base costume, tiger striped cat accessories such as ears, tail, optional cat nose and whisker makeup |
| Angie | White neighborhood cat who dislikes birds and mice | Base costume, cat accessories such as ears, tail, optional cat nose and whisker makeup |

| Pigeon | A gray pigeon who overhears the cats mischievous plans | Gray t-shirt, optional bird accessories such as wings, tail, beak |
| Mr. Clydesdale | A patient of Dr. Carey | Base costume - male |
| Miss Swenson | Dr. Carey's dental assistant | Base costume – female, optional dental assistant accessories such as medical face mask, medical gloves |
| Storekeeper | Owens a store in Connecticut that Stuart visits | Base costume |
| Harriet Ames | A girl about Stuart's size | Base costume - female |
| School Superintendent | Troubled superintendent | Base costume |
| School Children (Mary, Harry, Henry, Katherine and more) | Students whose teacher is out sick | Base costume – male or female |
| Telephone Repairman | Worker Stuart encounters on the road | Base costume with optional hardhat |

Stuart Little is set in the recent past. All Actors should wear a base costume that consists of casual chic (or somewhat nicer casual clothing). Please see examples below. All base costumes should be free from logos or graphics. Prints, solid colors, or stripes are preferred. Male characters can wear jeans with no holes or slacks, polos, button up shirts or sweaters. Female characters can wear dresses or skirt or jeans with no holes or slacks, polos, button up shirts or sweaters.

Hair should be pushed back out of your face; Make up should be used to highlight facial features. All actors are recommended to wear mascara, slightly darkened brows, pink or red lipstick or gloss, and a pink blush on cheeks.

Actors are encouraged to bring in costumes to any rehearsal for approval but all costumes are due May 13. Please keep costumes at home. Costumes should be worn for all rehearsals beginning May 20.
