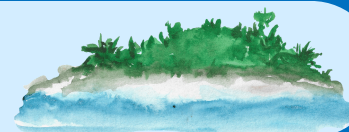
THINGS TO REMEMBER:

 - A Lunch

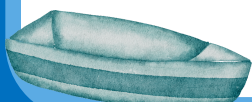
IMPORTANT DATES:
