### Living Tree Program

Donate a tree in the name of someone special or in honor of a special occasion. Trees will be planted in one of our beautiful parks.

Extraordinary events including births, anniversaries, weddings, retirements and graduations could be commemorated through the Geneva Park District's Living Tree Program.

Prices for trees include planting and maintenance. A memorial plaque can be ordered alongside a tree. Plaques can have up to 4 lines with a maximum of 20 characters (including spaces) per line. Finished plaque size is 4"hX8"w.

### Important Information for Planting and Maintenance

For the health of the trees, planting is done in the spring and fall. Requests made by the first Friday in March will be planted in the spring. Requests made by the first Friday in August will be planted in the fall.

The Park District will be responsible for acquisition, planting, watering, and caring of trees. Tree sponsors are not required to assist in the care of the tree, but can simply enjoy watching their gift grow.
